**Natalya Zeman** began the violin at the age of five studying by the Suzuki method. In 1997 she moved to Edinburgh and studied the violin initially with Mysie Ferguson and then with Claire Docherty at St Mary's Music School. While in Edinburgh Natalya led the National Children's Orchestra of Scotland and became a member of the National Youth Orchestra. In 2003, at the age of 13, Natalya performed as one half of a duo to the Earl and Countess of Wessex at Holyrood Palace, representing Scotland in a concert alongside Evelyn Glennie. She also performed at Edinburgh Castle in the presence of the First Minister. In 2004 Natalya took part in the Tianjin Children's Culture and Arts Festival performing both as a soloist and as leader of the NCOS String Chamber Orchestra. Natalya became a specialist musician at Wells Cathedral School in 2005 and performed with fellow pupils at the Shanghai International Music Festival. Last February she performed Szymanovski's 1st Violin Concerto with the School Symphony Orchestra after winning the School's concerto competition. Natalya is now studying at the Royal College of Music. Interest in English literature may take her on to university following this. She is performing this concerto on a violin made by Tony Padday.
